Description of memberships:

This membership allows the skater to contract ice, compete and test for BOTH the Golden Blades Skating School (*ISI*) and the Flagg Pond Skating Club (*USFS*) skating teams. Members in good standing will be invited to participate in all team parties, activities, *ISI* and *USFS* competitions and test sessions. Skaters will receive BOTH **ISI AND USFS** memberships, team newsletters, email blasts and the privilege to skate on one of our synchronized skating teams. Full members will receive top priority for contracting ice time on a first come first serve basis. Members are required to follow all team rules (please see attached form), participate in two mandatory fundraisers, and contract at least one session of the teams' freestyle ice time per week from September – June.

*Jr. Membership: This membership is for new members who will be participating in semi private lesson during the 09-10 skating season. Skaters may be Jr. members for only one skating season. Skaters will receive an ISI membership, team newsletter, email blasts and the privilege to skate on one of our synchronized formation teams. GOLDEN BLADES/FLAGG POND TEAM EXPECTATIONS

Skater:

- ☐ Use the assigned locker room every time you come to skate. It will be posted on the big screen TV in the lobby to the information booth.
- ☐ Sign in before getting on the ice.
- ☐ If you are skating an extra hour, or day, other than your scheduled times, you are considered a walk on person. You are to check in and pay for ice before the session starts.
- ☐ Keep a good sportsmanship like attitude! Be friendly to all skaters.
- ☐ Show a mutual respect for other skaters and coaches.
- ☐ Arrive at least ten minutes before your session starts.
- ☐ The stronger skater always takes the outside
- ☐ A skater on lesson has the right of way
- ☐ DO NOT interrupt a skater or coach while on lesson
- ☐ Skating attire is required. Hair is to be pulled back. *If you look like a skater, you'll feel like a skater!*
- ☐ Stretch off ice
- ☐ Programs should be skated every session you skate.
- ☐ Music will be played in order they arrive, unless the skater is on lesson.
- ☐ Skaters MUST wear the orange vest when their music is being played.
- ☐ Take good care of your equipment.
- ☐ Help out at all shows, exhibitions, competitions, club parties, fundraisers etc...
- ☐ Read all posted notices at the rink and on the website. Be informed of all due dates...
- ☐ Return applications and forms on time!
- ☐ No eating on the ice
- ☐ Clean up after yourself!
- ☐ As a team member you should always strive to maintain a grade point average suitable to your parents in all schoolwork
- ☐ Always show respect for the team coaches, the rink, and its equipment
- ☐ Remember that you are a representative of your team at all times. Your behavior inside and outside of the rink should leave a positive impression on others! Negative conversation circulating amongst the skaters is harmful.

Parent Rules:

- ☐ Get your skater to the rink on time.
- ☐ If your skater is skating an extra hour, or day, other than your scheduled times, you are considered a walk on person. You are to check in and pay for ice before that session starts.
- ☐ Return all forms and applications on time with the appropriate fees.
- ☐ If a skater must miss a lesson you are responsible to contact your professional 24 hours before their scheduled lesson or you will be charged for the lesson.
- ☐ If your skater misses a contracted ice time, the time must be made up within that current session or it will be forfeited
- ☐ Viewing practices should be from the warm room or bleaches.
- ☐ NO parent coaching: this is what you pay your professional for.
- ☐ Keep a positive attitude (support your skater, coach, team)
- ☐ Make your skater feel good even when they are not skating well.
- ☐ Do not compare skaters, nothing is more destructive, every skater will progress differently.
- ☐ Supply good equipment: skates should fit properly and blades sharpened on a regular basis.
- ☐ This team is run by volunteers, by helping out at all shows, exhibitions, competitions, club parties, fundraisers etc... you are showing your child you support their skating interests.
- ☐ Get your information first hand. If you have a question, ask your coach or speak directly to the team director.
